### Planning Commission

The Planning Commission consists of seven members who are appointed by the Town Council. Familiarity with the Town's current General Plan, the Moraga Center Specific Plan and zoning regulations as well as land use planning and Environmental Quality Act requirements is preferred.

#### Duties:

- Attend meetings as an appointed member.
- Review, evaluate and decide land use applications in accordance with the Town's policies and regulations.
- Review the Town's General Plan.
- Review and recommend zoning code regulations.
- Recommend the reclassifications of a property's zoning.
- Review subdivision maps.
- Act on variances, special use permits, site plan and architectural reviews, and other types of planning applications.
- Review and recommend special studies.

**Term of Office:** 2 year term

**Meetings:** Held on the **first and third Monday of every month** at the Town Council Chambers and Community Meeting Room, 335 Rheem Boulevard, Moraga
